Global leaders gather together to shape the future of mobility at the Global Mobility Conference 2024 under the theme of Innovation Futures: Beyond the Horizon.

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport (MOLIT, Minister PARK Sang-woo) in collaboration with the Korea Transportation Safety Authority (TS, Chairman of the Board of Directors JEONG Yong-sik), the International Transport Forum (ITF, Secretary-General KIM Young-tae) at the OECD, and Korean Society of Transportation (President JEONG Jin-hyeok) is hosting the Global Mobility Conference 2024 on 12-13 December in Seoul.

The Global Mobility Conference aims to strengthen international cooperation in mobility sector and explore cutting-edge trends and technologies related to the industry such as autonomous driving, Urban Air Mobility (UAM), and sustainable transportation to show future directions for innovation.

In particular, the Global Mobility Conference this year will be held jointly with the ITF's Beyond the Horizon Conference bringing experts and leaders from over 40 global organizations and corporations, including Azerbaijan government, the International Road Federation, the International Road Transport Union, as well



as Toyota (Japan), Hyundai Motor Company, Pony AI (China) in mobility industry, and so forth.

The theme of the conference "Innovation Futures: Beyond the Horizon" will address public roles and private sector collaboration systems in various forums dealing with critical issues like overcoming social conflicts, safety challenges, and the so-called "chasm" by mobility innovation to achieve sustainable societal development.
