

No Noise from Air Ways to Assist the CSAT 2025

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport (MOLIT, Minister PARK Sang-woo) will be completely controlling all aircraft takeoffs and landings nationwide for 35 minutes from 1:05 PM to 1:40 PM on Thursday 14 November 2024 (KST) during the English listening session of the College Scholastic Ability Test (CSAT) 2025.

Excepting flights for emergency and urgent aircrafts, all others in flight during the time slot will be required to wait at least 3 kilometers above the ground while being restricted for all others' takeoffs and landings.

In accordance with this measure, the schedules of 156 flights, including 58 international and 98 domestic ones, will be adjusted and all those relevant Airlines are supposed to provide passengers with advance notifications regarding any changes to flight schedules.

The MOLIT will be maintaining a real-time cooperation system along with air traffic control agencies, Korea Airports Corporation, Incheon International Airport Corporation, and the Airlines for the hour to ensure smooth implementation of the flight restrictions and to minimize delays or air traffic congestion by activating air traffic flow management measures such as adjusting flight departure times in advance, and so forth.
