

Korea-UAE Agree to Increase Flight Rights from 15 to 21 times A Week for the First Time in 14 Years

- Aviation talks between Korea and the United Arab Emirates (12~13 Oct.) to

compromise on increasing air traffic rights between the two countries

- Expected to enhance the convenience of travel between the two countries and

significantly expand people and logistics exchanges

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport (MOLIT, Minister WON Hee-ryong) held an Aviation Talks* with the General Civil Aviation Authority

(GCAA) of the United Arab Emirates (UAE) in Seoul on 12~13 October to agree

on the increase of international air traffic rights** between the two countries.

agreement between the two governments.

The UAE is a key partner country in the Middle East with active economic

exchanges, such as a \$30 billion investment commitment in Korean companies

made last January and the second largest cumulative amount of overseas

construction orders (\$83.5 billion), and through this meeting, the bilateral

cooperation will be expanded to the air transportation sector.



With this bilateral agreement, the number of flights between Korea and the UAE will be increased from 15 times to 21 times a week, which is a total of 6 flights increased per week being expected to expand opportunities for people and logistics exchanges between the two countries.

For reference, the increase in the traffic rights this time between the two countries has been 14 years since the agreement on the increase of 7 more flights a week (from 8 to 15 times a week) was made back in 2009.

MOLIT Director General for Aviation Policy KIM Young-guk expressed, "Through this agreement, expansion of fresh booming in the Middle East region such as more Korean companies' entering into the market, and increase in the convenience and selective options for people to travel long distances, including Europe and Africa, are expected to enhance".
